1 John 1:8-9

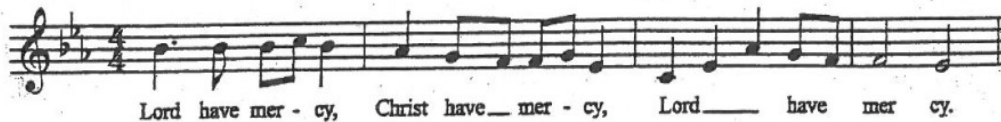
