## CALL TO CONFESSION

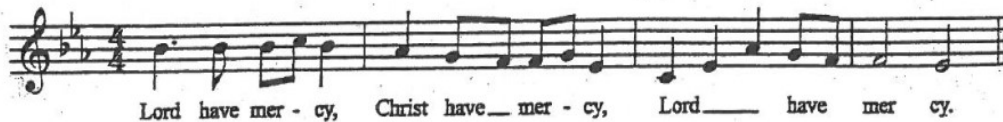
God is not far from us. When trouble is near, God is our help and our refuge. Let us confess our sins to God, that we might receive mercy.
