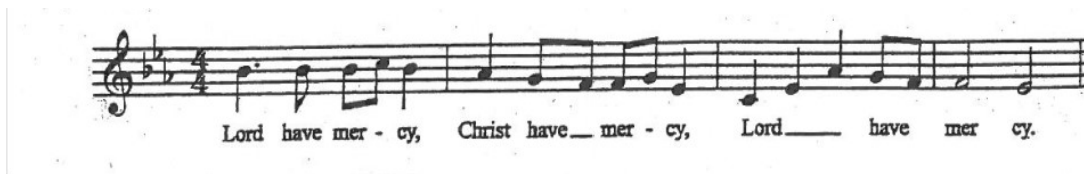
## PRAYER OF CONFESSION
