Advent Adventure—Thank You

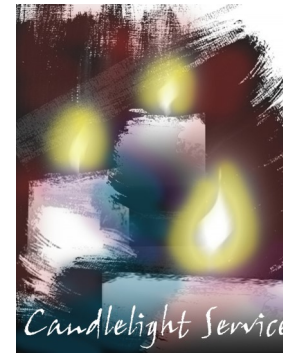
