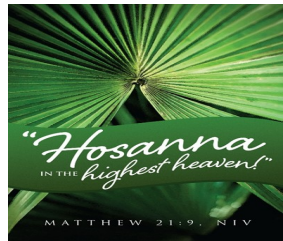

Palms on Sunday-Next Sunday

As we reflect on Palm Sunday, we can be thankful that Trinity and over a 1,000 other congregations supported Eco-Palms. The *Eco-Palm Project* provides an opportunity to purchase high quality *Chamaedorea* palm fronds— a purchase which supports indigenous communities in Guatemala and Mexico, as well as preserves the rainforest. Though it seems like a small project, use of the Eco-Palms means that an increase of 250% of the money from the palms is going directly back into the harvesting communities.
