CURRENT Article III, Section A

As defined by the Book of Order, Session is the governing body of Trinity Presbyterian Church in Fairfield. Session will consist of the PASTOR(S) and nine (9) active Elders. The term of office of each Elder shall be three years.

MODIFIED Article III, Section A

- A. As defined by the Book of Order, Session is the governing body of Trinity Presbyterian Church in Fairfield. Session will consist of the PASTOR(S) and a number of active Elders, depending on the current active membership of the church. The membership of the session shall be divided into three (3) equal classes. Session shall consist of six (6) Elders for an active Church membership 99 or less, nine (9) Elders for an active Church membership 100-199, and twelve (12) Elders for an active Church membership 200 or more. The term of office of each Elder shall be three years.

CURRENT Article III, Section B

The Board of Deacons shall consist of nine (9) members divided into three equal classes. The term of office shall be three years.

MODIFIED Article III, Section B

The Board of Deacons shall consist of a number of members depending on the current total active membership within the church. The Board of Deacons shall consist of six (6) members for an active Church membership 99 or less, nine (9) members for an active Church membership 100-199, and twelve (12) members for an active Church membership 200 or more.
